

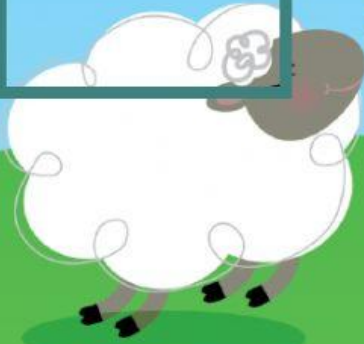
Addition – Word Problems:
