IV. Phylum Chordata

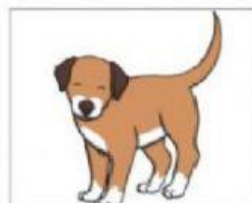
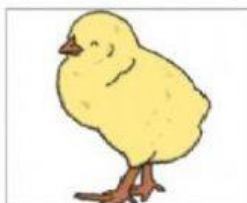
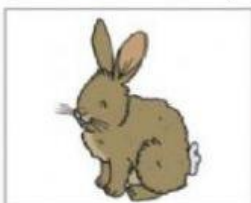
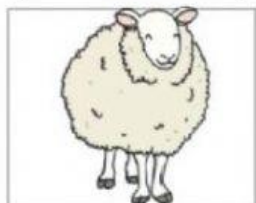
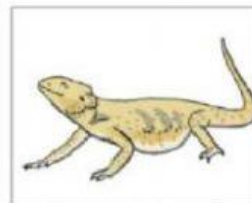
Phylum Chordata are animals that have a backbone.

Classes under Phylum Chordata:

Fish	Amphibian	Reptiles	Birds	Mammals
- They live in water and have scales - Breathe through their gills - Most of them lays eggs	- They live both in water and land - They have moist skin - They are born with gills and later develop lungs	- They live mostly on land - They have a dry, thick skin covered with scales - Most are hatched from eggs	- They have feathers and a beak - Some of them can fly - They lay eggs	- They have hair or fur - They feed their young with milk - Mostly give birth to young animals

- They are the only arthropods with wings - They have six legs and a pair of antennae - They have compound eyes	- They have eight legs - They use silk to catch their prey - They have a pair of clamps in their mouth	- They mostly live in water - They have ten legs - They have two pairs of antennae	- They have more than ten legs. - They have two body sections: head and trunk - They have a pair of antennae
