Study these following patterns.

a. Possitive (Verbal Sentence)

Nominal Sentence

I, She, He, It	Was	an elementary student two years ago
They, We, You	Were	in Bali last vacation.

b. Negative

Possitive (Verbal Sentence)

I, They, We, You,	did not + Verb 1	football yesterday
She, He , It	didn't play	to Jakarta last week
	didn't go	

Nominal Sentence

I, He, She, It	was not	an elementary student two years ago
They, We, You	Were not	in Bali last vacation.

c. Interrogative

Did	I, You, We, They, She, He, It	play football yesterday / go to Jakarta last week	?
Was	I, She, He, It	an elementary student two years ago	?
Were	They, We, You	a dancer few years ago	?
