1. Saif has 9 balloons. Reem has 3 times more balloons than said does. How many balloons does Reem have?
2. A restaurant sold 6 hamburgers every day for a week. How many did they sell altogether?
3. A restaurant sells 7 chocolate ice-creams every day in October. How many did they sell in the whole month?
4. Rashed bought 77 Pokemon cards costing \$4 each. How much money did he spend in total?
5. 8 runners ran 23km each for a charity race. How much did they run altogether?
6. The hotel cost \$245 each night to stay. Juliette's family stayed 6 nights. How much did it cost altogether?
7. Haya has \$55. Noora has 5 times as much. What is the **difference** between how much they each have?
8. Max and Ebrahim each have a business. Max makes \$534 every but only wants to work for 1 week. Ebrahim makes \$272 every day for 2 weeks. Who makes the most money?
How much more did they make than the other person?
9. 17 classes are going to the performance and there are 32 students in each class. How many are going in total?
10. Mr. Young orders 346kg of potatoes for his restaurant every month. How many kg of potatoes would that be in a whole year?
11. Mohammed decides to practice 25 maths questions every day for a whole year. If he is successful, how many questions would he have practiced?
