

HOW WE MAKE BREAD...

PUT THE SENTENCES IN ORDER...

After about an hour, the baker takes the bread out of the oven and leaves it to cool down.

At a factory, a baker mixes the flour with salt, water and yeast to make dough.

At the mill, a machine grinds it into flour.

1. Bread is a very popular food. Often, people eat it with every meal. But where does it come from and how do people make it?

11. Finally, a delivery driver takes the bread to the shop, where a shop assistant sells it to customers.

The baker puts the loaves on trays and then puts them in the oven to bake.

Then someone takes it to the flour mill.

Then, a slicing machine slices the bread and a different machine puts it into plastic bags.

Usually, people make bread from wheat, which a farmer grows in a field.

When the dough has risen, the baker cuts it into pieces, and shapes the pieces into loaves.

When the wheat is ripe, a farmer harvests it.
