

QUESTION STRUCTURE

✓ Auxiliary for **simple present** = **do, does**

Sentence	Yes-no question	WH question
She works in a hotel	Does she work in a hotel	Where does she work ?
I usually travel on vacations	Do you usually travel on vacations?	What do you usually do on vacations?

✓ Auxiliary for **simple present with verb be** = **is, are, am** * remember verb to be itself is an auxiliary verb, too, so it doesn't need another helping auxiliary verb

Sentence	Yes-no question	WH question
The hotel is luxurious	Is the hotel luxurious	What is the hotel like?
Children are naïve	Are children naïve?	What are children like?

✓ Auxiliary for **simple past** = **did**

Sentence	Yes-no question	WH question
I slept in a hotel yesterday	Did you sleep in a hotel yesterday?	Where did you sleep yesterday?
Alex enjoyed the trip a lot	Did Alex enjoy the trip?	How did he like the trip?

✓ Auxiliary for **simple past with verb be** = **was, were** * remember verb to be itself is an auxiliary verb, too, so it doesn't need another helping auxiliary verb

Sentence	Yes-no question	WH question
John was at home last night	Was John at home last night?	Where was John last night?
You were sad that day	Were you sad that day?	Why were you sad that day?

✓ Auxiliary for **true modal verbs** = **will, should, can, could, would, may**
remember true modals themselves are auxiliary verbs, too, so they don't need another helping auxiliary verb
✓ **Questions with **must** are not common, it is better to make the question with **should** instead.

Sentence	Yes-no question	WH question
I will get married in my 30's, maybe	Will you get married in your 30's?	When will you get married?
I can work all day long	Can you work all day long?	How long can you work ?
They should study harder	Should they study harder?	Why should they study harder?
** We must read carefully	Should they read carefully?	Why should they read carefully?

✓ Auxiliary for **present continuous** = **is, are, am** (ing-verb) * remember verb to be itself is an auxiliary verb, too, so it doesn't need another helping auxiliary verb

Sentence	Yes-no question	WH question
Sue is working on Mondays	Is Sue working on Mondays	When is Sue working ?

Jeremy and I are studying French in the academy	Are you studying French in the academy?	Where are Jeremy and you studying French?
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✓ Auxiliary for **past continuous** = **was, were** (ing-verb) * remember verb to be itself is an auxiliary verb, too, so it doesn't need another helping auxiliary verb

Sentence	Yes-no question	WH question
I was doing homework at that time	Were you doing homework at that time?	What were you doing at that time?
They were making their beds when the phone rang	Were they making their beds when the phone rang?	What were they doing when the phone rang?

✓ Auxiliary for **be going to** = **is/ are, am/** (going to + verb in simple form). * remember verb to be itself is an auxiliary verb, too, so it doesn't need another helping auxiliary verb

Sentence	Yes-no question	WH question
I am going to stay to the beach for 5 days	Are you going to stay the beach for 5 days?	How long are you going to stay the beach?
These people are going to travel Cancun next week.	Are these people going to travel Cancun next week?	Where are these people going to travel next week?
