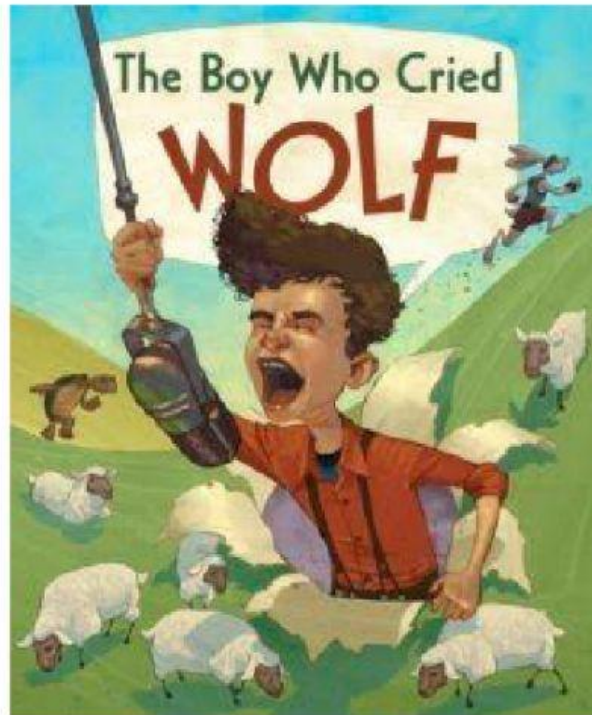
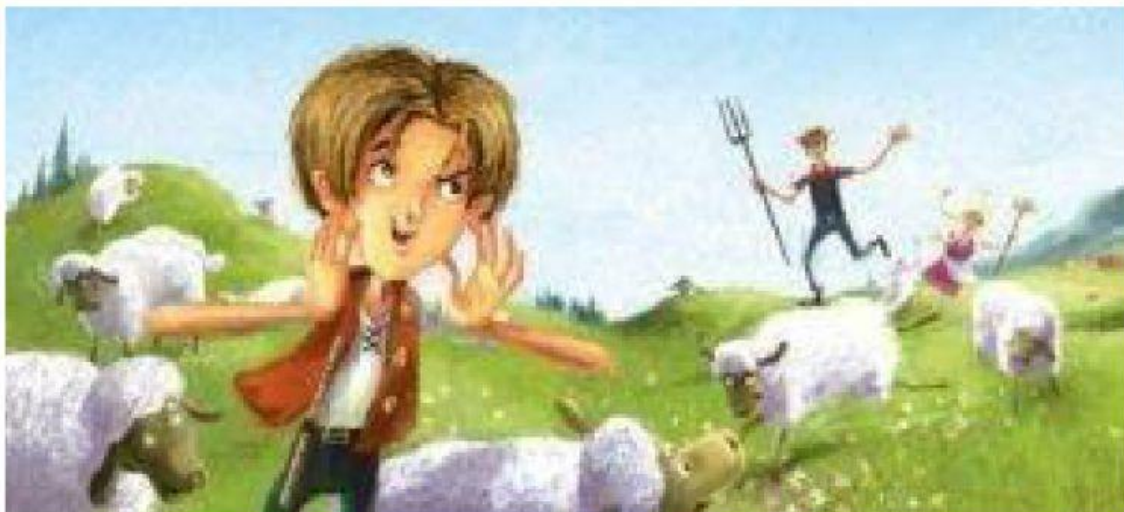


The Boy Who Cried Wolf
