V- Verb **A-** Adjective **N-** Noun **P-** Preposition **VP-** Verb Phrase

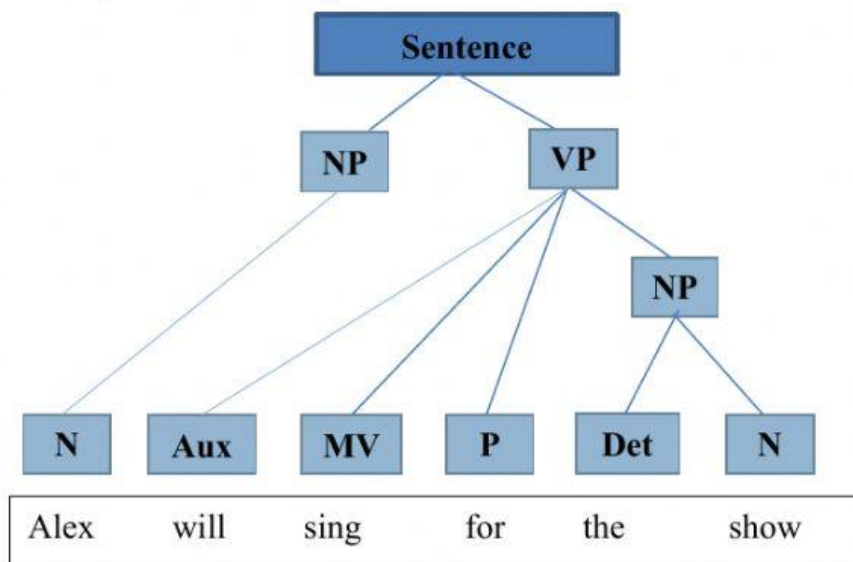
Adj. P- Adjective Phrase **NP-** Noun Phrase **PP-** Prepositional Phrase

MV- Main Verb **Aux-** Auxiliary Verb **Det-** Determiner

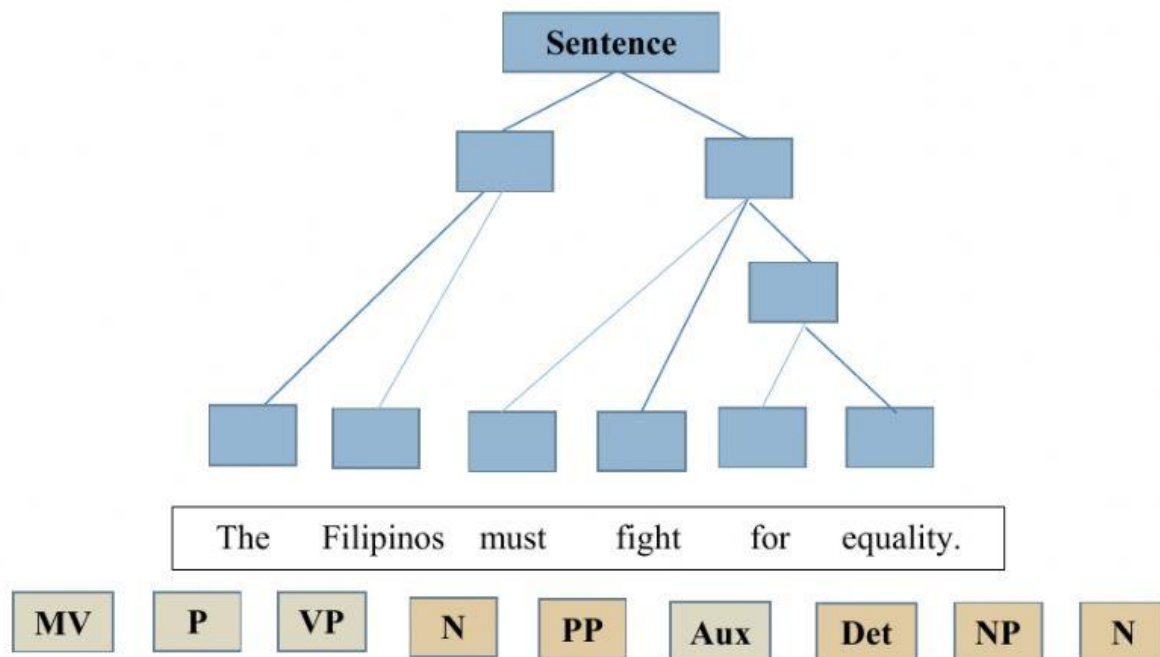
Com- Verb Complement **Adv. P-** Adverb Phrase **Pr-** Pronoun

Art- Article

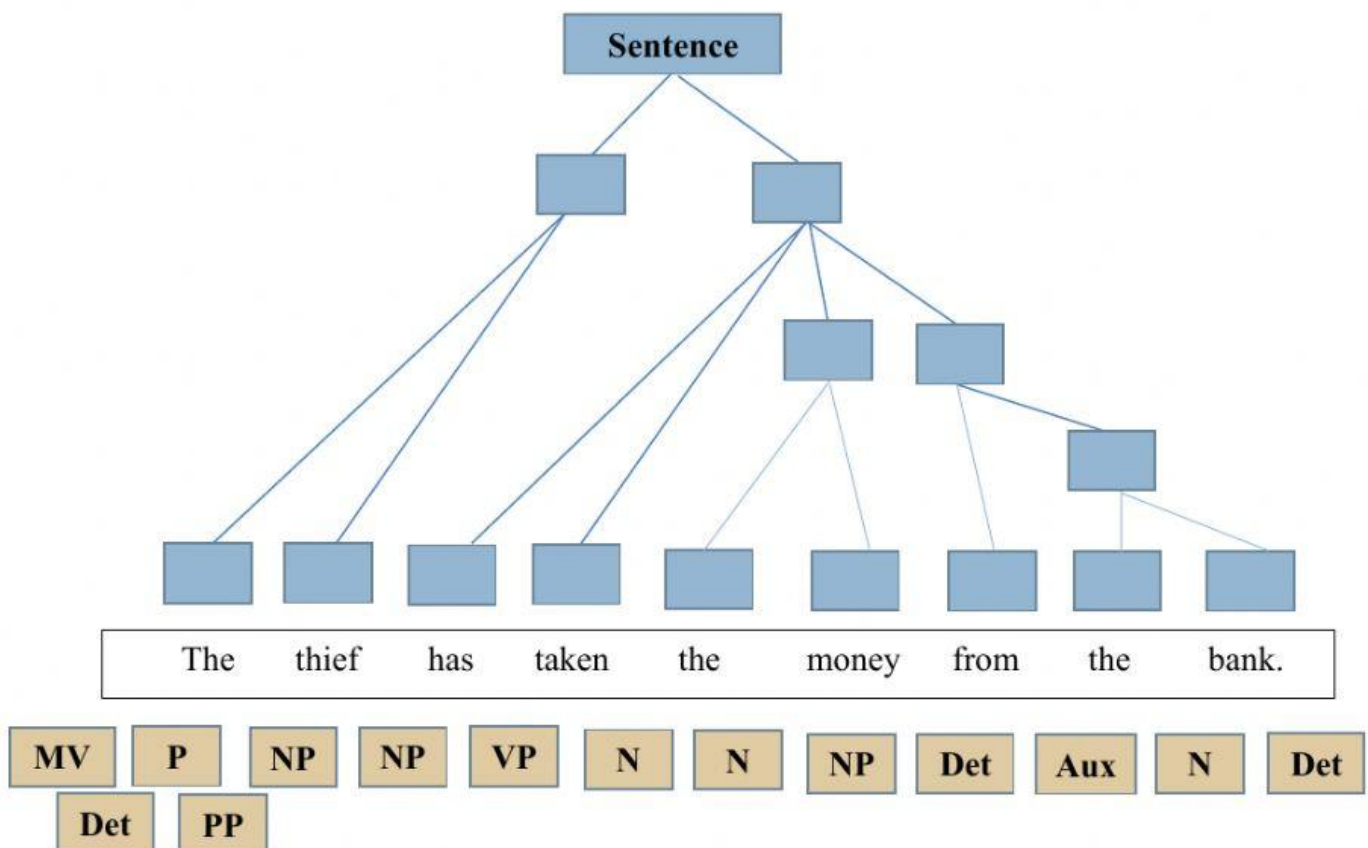
