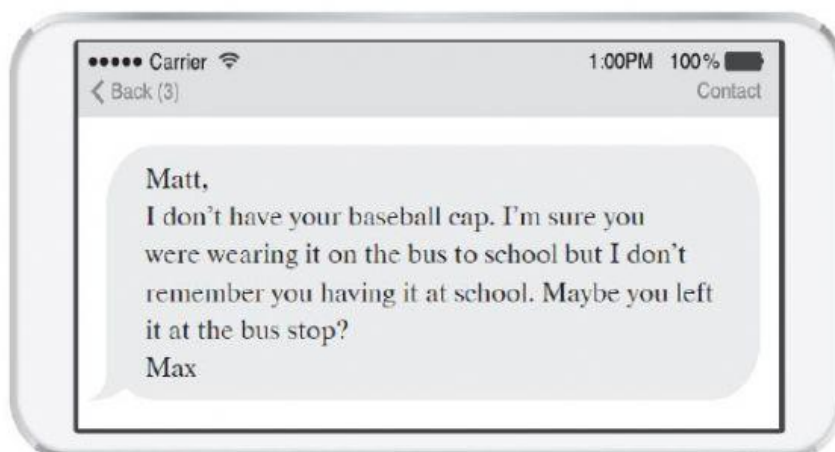


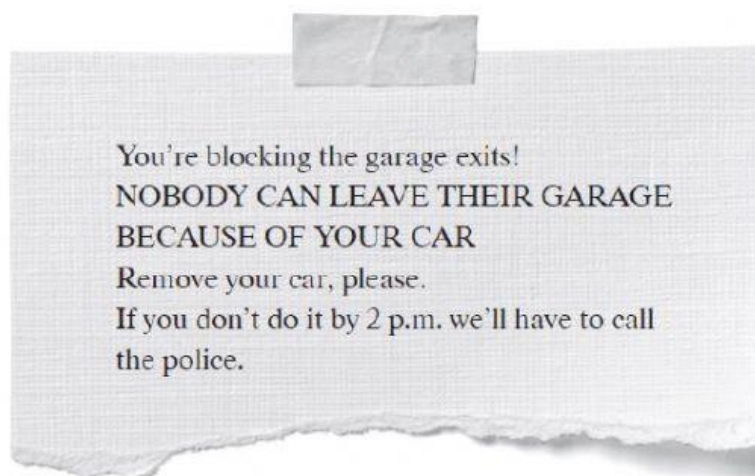


7.1. This message was written by a person who
