


SHARK FACTS

- The shark is a type of **FISH** that lives in the ocean.
- Sharks can have from 1 to 100 babies at a time. Baby sharks are called **PUPS**.
- Some sharks lay eggs, like birds. Some others hatch eggs inside the mother and then are born. Some other pups grow inside the mother, like humans.
- They are **carnivores**. They eat other fish and sea mammals like dolphins. They even eat smaller sharks!
- They can swim **very fast** and they keep their **big mouth open** while swimming.
- They are covered in **rough scales**. They look like tiny teeth!
- Sharks have many teeth. They can have about six rows of **sharp teeth** to bite and hold their prey, the animals they hunt. If a tooth is broken or lost, a new tooth comes out.
