

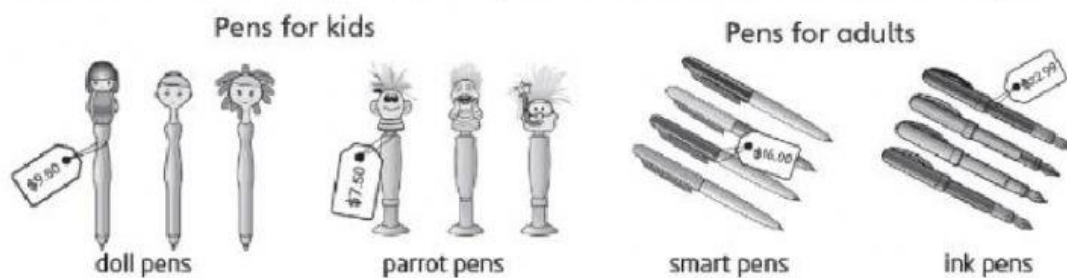
Comparatives with *more* + adjective

The new house is		modern		the old one.

Use *more* + adjective + *than* with . . .

- some two-syllable adjectives (*modern*)
- all adjectives with three or more syllables (*difficult, expensive, interesting*)

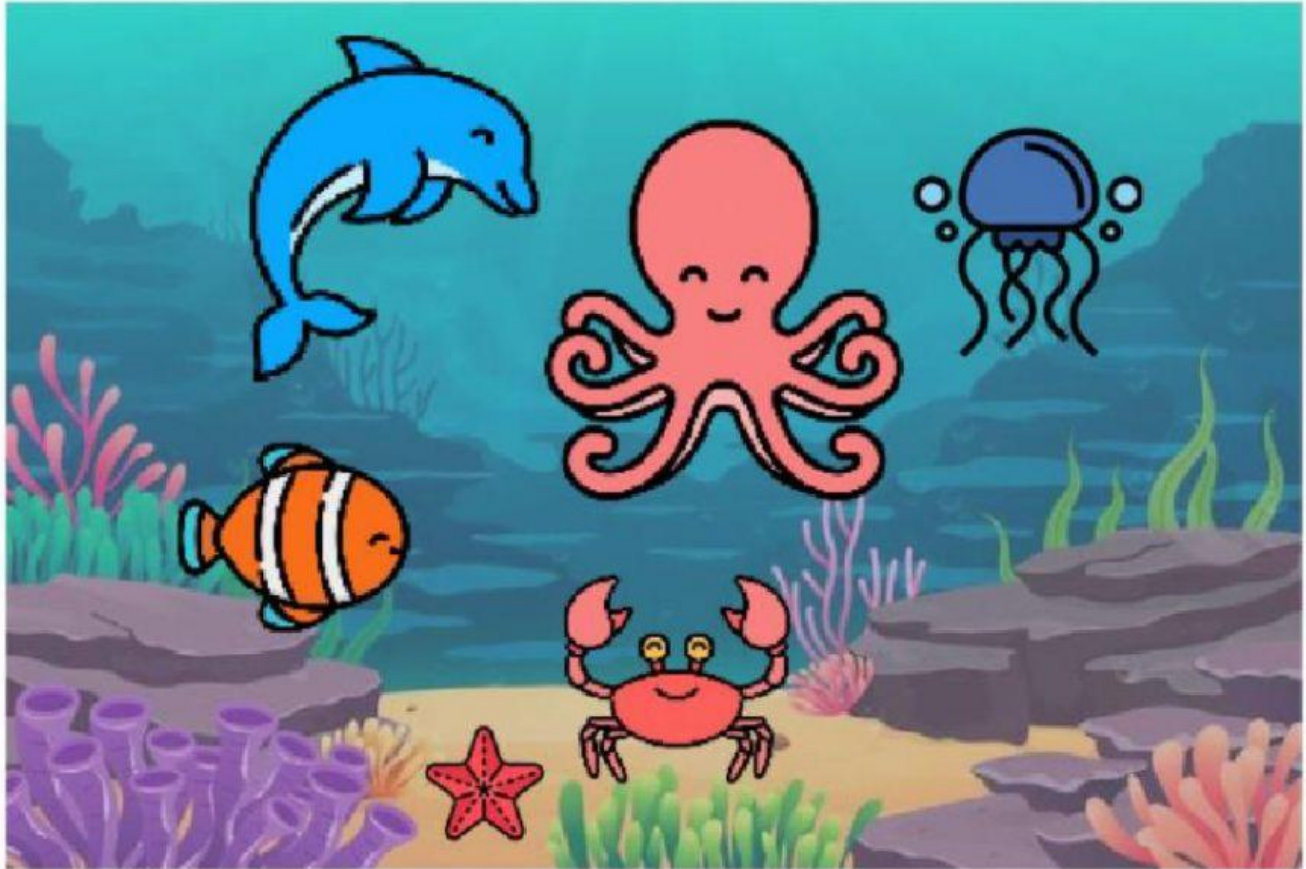
