FIRST CONDITIONAL - REAL POSSIBILITY

| If | Condition | Result |
|----|-------------------|-------------------------|
| | Present simple | Will/won't + base verb |
| If | she studies hard, | she will pass the exam. |

| Result | If | Condition |
|-------------------------|----------------|------------------|
| Will/won't + base verb | Present simple | Present simple |
| She will pass the exam. | if | she studies hard |

We use the first conditional when there is a **real possibility** that this condition will happen in the future. Remember the **s** for the third person singular (present simple).

Example: If it rains, I won't go to the beach
