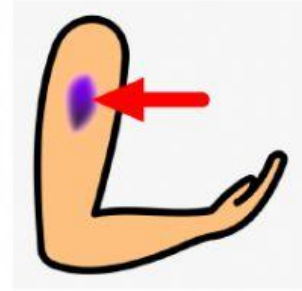

cheer up *verb* If you cheer up, you stop feeling sad and start feeling happy.

drop off/cheer up

drop off *verb* If you drop someone off, you take them somewhere they need to go in a car and leave them there.
