

The Origin of Coins

According to the Greek historian Herodotus, the Lydian people were the first to use (49)_____ coins. In fact, these earliest coins were made out (50)_____ electrum, a naturally-occurring mixture of gold and silver. The coins were first produced in (51)_____ century BC with a design on one side only; (52)_____ was marked with simple punches. Each coin was assigned value in units. Some coins were inscribed with names in Lydian script, but it is unclear if these

are names of kings or just of rich men who produced the coins. Because of the irregular size and shape of the coins, it must have been difficult to tell one from another, especially some of the smaller ones. Thus, many costs (53)_____ in terms of the total weight of the coins required and transactions were completed by weighing the coins used together rather than counting individual ones.
