HOME MEDICINE

1 A SORE THROAT
Does your throat hurt?

- Put a dirty sock around your neck before you go to sleep and wear it all night. Your throat will be better in the morning.
- Drink a cup of hot tea with honey. Your throat will feel better.



2 SMELLY FEET
Are you afraid to take off your shoes?

- Put two tea bags in four cups of warm water. Put your feet in the tea for ten minutes a day. Your feet will always smell sweet.



3 A COLD
Do you want to stay healthy all winter?

- Tie a big red onion* to your bed and the colds will stay away.



4 HEADACHE
Do you hate those headaches?

- Rub a lemon on your forehead. The headache will go away.



5 TOOTHACHE
Does your tooth hurt?

- Tie a string around your little toe and the toothache will go away.



6 STOMACH ACHE
Does your stomach hurt?

- Rub some olive oil* on your stomach. Then put garlic* in your belly button*. The pain will disappear.



7 HICCUPS*
Do you want to make those hiccups go away?

- Stand straight, put your arms over your head and move your fingers.
