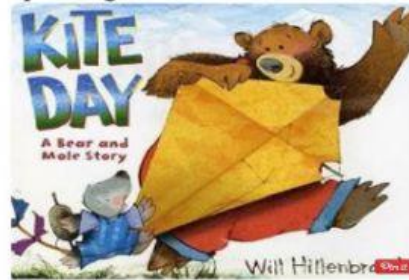
Task 1. Read the story and match.
