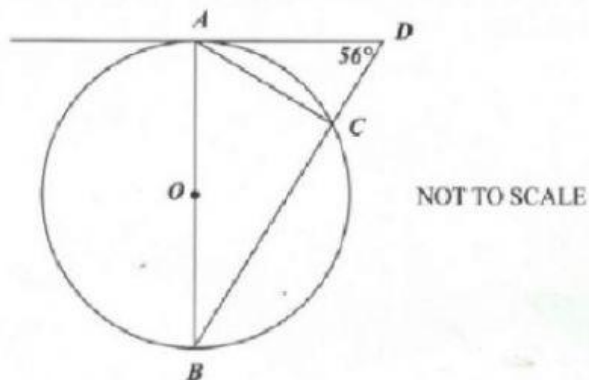


Circle Theorems

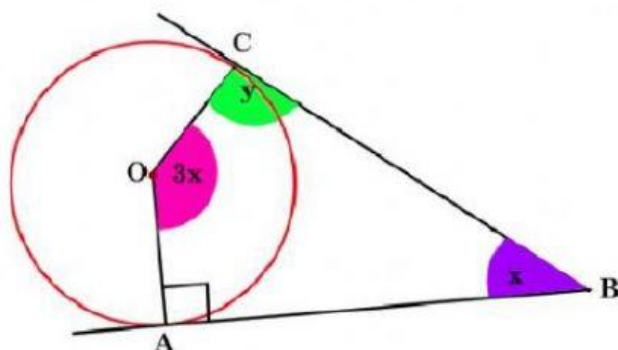
Answer the questions below.

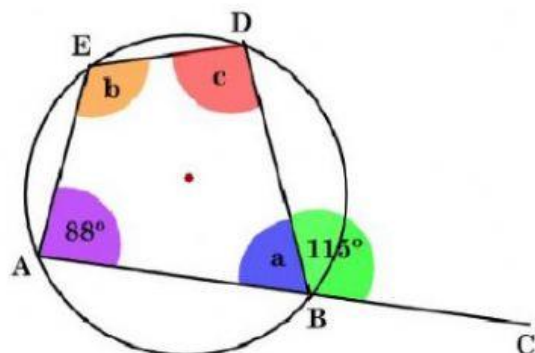

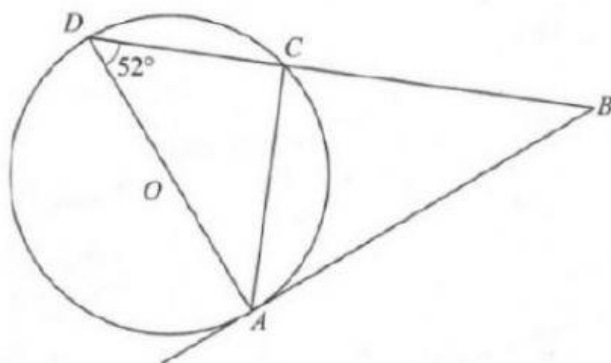
