

Head proportions

A. Watch the video on drawing the head.
B. Put the steps in the correct order.

- The bottom third dividing line becomes our eye line.
- Draw the eyes so that the distance between them is equal to one eye.
- Draw two horizontal lines that divide it in three equal parts.
- The eyebrows' height should be about half of an eye above the eyes.
- Draw the chin shape.
- Draw a circle.
- The top third part becomes the mouth line.
- Draw the nose in the (middle) bottom of the circle.
- Draw the ears between these two lines.
- Draw another horizontal line so that the distance between the eye line and the bottom of the circle is the same as the distance between the bottom of the circle and the new line.
- Divide the space between the bottom of the nose and the bottom of the chin into three.
- Draw a vertical line in the middle of it.
- Draw one horizontal line from the top of the eyebrows and another line from the bottom of the nose.
