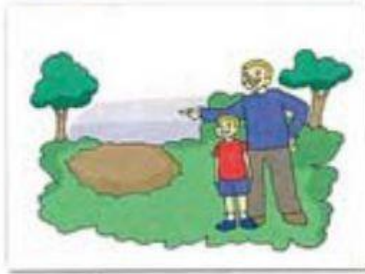
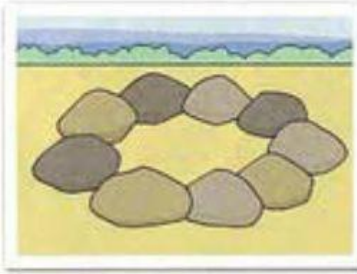


Making a Campfire



1. Ask an adult to help you. Together, look for flat dirt or sand.



2. Make a circle with rocks on that ground.



3. Find some wood for the fire. You need some very small sticks and some big sticks.



4. Find some dry leaves or grass. Put these inside the rock circle. Light them with a match.



5. Put the small sticks on top of the burning grass. Wait for them to start burning.



6. Put the big sticks on top. Add more sticks to keep the campfire going. Remember, put out the fire before you leave!
