4. This shot is most frequently used for mid to long-range shots, including shooting beyond the arc.	D. Dunk
5. This shot is made from short range by a player moving towards the basket. Usually utilizing the backboard if he approaches the hoop from an angle. This is also one of the most basic and common ways of scoring a basket in the game.	E. Free Throw
