Benito Juárez

Benito Pablo Juárez García was **born** in San Pablo Guelatao, Oaxaca, Mexico, on **March 21, 1806**. He lived and worked as shepherd with his uncle until he was thirteen. Then he moved to the city of Oaxaca, Mexico, with his sister.

In Oaxaca, Juárez _____ to Don Antonio Salanueva, a Franciscan friar, who helped him enter the Seminary of Santa Cruz where he learned to read and write specially in Spanish. In **1834**, he achieved his law degree from Science and Arts Institute.

In **1841**, Juárez got married with Margarita Mazza, the daughter of one of Oaxaca's wealthiest families.

In 1847, Benito Juarez was _____ as Governor of Oaxaca but in 1853 the Conservatory Party forced him to leave the country and Juarez was exiled in Cuba and New Orleans. In 1854, Juan Alvarez _____ the capitol and proclaimed himself as President of Mexico, who helped Juarez to return and proclaimed him as Minister of Justice. In 1856, Felix Zuloaga put Juarez in prison but one year later Zuloaga was forced to let him free.

That year, Juarez _____ the 26th President of Mexico. Juarez governed Mexico but France _____ the country, in 1862 Ignacio Zaragoza defeated the French army and that battle is well-known as Battle of Puebla and celebrated on May 5th.

Juarez was _____ in 1867 and 1871. On July 18, 1872, the president suffered from a stroke and _____ at his desk.
