How to Spot A Liar?

I. Vocabulary

bouncer - a person employed by a nightclub or similar establishment to prevent troublemakers from entering or to eject them from the premises

dishonesty - lack of honesty, deceit

your (fair) share - if you have had your share of something, for example problems, success, or adventure, a lot of it has happened to you

tall story - a story that is so unlikely that it is difficult to believe

spin - to turn around and around very quickly, or to make something do this

Frank Bruno - a British former boxer whose career highlight was winning the WBC heavyweight championship in 1995.

curb (AmE)/kerb (BrE) - the edge of the pavement (=raised path) at the side of a road

the stakes are high - if the stakes are high when you are trying to do something, you risk losing a lot or it will be dangerous if you fail

smirk - to smile in an unpleasant way that shows that you are pleased by someone else's bad luck or think you are better than other people

pull the wool over your eyes - to deceive someone by not telling the truth
