YES / NO QUESTIONS	WH QUESTIONS
If there is a yes/no question, use "if" in the reported question and change the form of the verb one step back into the past.	In wh questions, we need to disappear the auxiliary and make any necessary changes in the verb. We also need to change the order of the words as in an affirmative sentence.
Direct question Charly: "Do you play football?" Reported question Charly asked me if I played football.	Direct question Charly: "When do you play football?" Reported question Charly asked me when I played football.
