

Practice 4 Addition with Regrouping in Tens and Ones

1. Add and regroup the tens and ones.
Show your workings.

Example

$$488 + 123 = ?$$

First, add the ones.

$$8 \text{ ones} + 3 \text{ ones} = \underline{11} \text{ ones}$$

Regroup the ones.

$$11 \text{ ones} = \underline{1} \text{ ten } \underline{1} \text{ one}$$

Then, add the tens.

$$1 \text{ ten} + 8 \text{ tens} + 2 \text{ tens} = \underline{11} \text{ tens}$$

Regroup the tens.

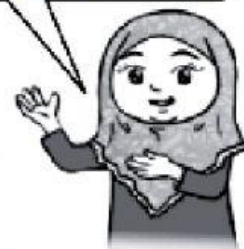
$$11 \text{ tens} = \underline{1} \text{ hundred } \underline{1} \text{ ten}$$

Lastly, add the hundreds.

$$1 \text{ hundred} + 4 \text{ hundreds} + 1 \text{ hundred} = \underline{6} \text{ hundreds}$$

$$\text{So, } 488 + 123 = \underline{611}.$$

Write $488 + 123$
in this way.
Then, add.



$$\begin{array}{r} \overset{1}{4} \overset{1}{8} 8 \\ + 1 2 3 \\ \hline 6 1 1 \end{array}$$
