Some animals living in the oceans are threatened or endangered for numbers of reasons. Some of them died because of water pollution from spilled oil and other toxic chemicals. Animals like turtles are killed because of their shells. A lot of turtle eggs did not survive because they are eaten by other animals and human.

Other animals like whales are also killed as they are frequently accidentally caught in fishing nets. There is also overfishing in which too many animals are caught for human consumption.

The pollution also destroy some of marine habitat. Coral reefs are home to many animals and their food. The destruction of the coral reefs caused the animals to lose their home and food. There are also a lot of trash in the oceans. Animals like turtles accidentally eaten the trash that looks like jellyfish. This cause them to die.
