

Questions in the Present Simple Practice 3

To form simple questions with the verb "to be," you change the order of the subject and verb.

Ex: **It is** 1 o'clock. **They are** gardeners. **I am** late.
 Is it 1 o'clock? **Are they** gardeners? **Am I** late?

For questions without the verb "to be," start the question with "do" or "does. In the question, the main verb is always in its base form. Do not add -s for he, she, or it.

Example: He cooks dinner every Sunday. They work from 9am to 5pm.
 Does he cook dinner every Sunday? **Do** they work from 9am to 5pm?
