The flag of Canada in the present form was made the official flag of Canada on 15 February 1965, replacing the old one that has Union Jack - the British flag. Since 1996, February 15 has been observed annually as National Flag of Canada Day. The flag is known by different names but is generally called the 'National Flag of Canada'. It is also known as 'The Maple Leaf' or l'Unifolié, which means 'the one-leaved' in French.

The National Flag of Canada consists of two colours: white and red. These are the official colours of Canada as proclaimed by King George V of Britain in 1921. Both colours have historical significance. While the white refers to the French royal emblem used in the reign of Charles VII, the red symbolizes the cross of St. George, which was the emblem of the first flag that flew in Canada.

The most **distinctive** feature of the National Flag of Canada is the 11-pointed red maple leaf that is placed in the centre of the flag. The flag is also special for its size. The dimensions of the flag - twice as long as it is wide - are unique to Canada. No other national flag uses those dimensions. The National Flag of Canada is a symbol of pride and honour for the people of Canada. Needless to say, it should be treated, used and displayed with respect.
