Present Continuous Affirmative

We use the **present continuous** for actions that

- are in progress at the time of speaking.
*Robbie and Jake **are running** in the race.*
- are in progress around the time of speaking.
*These days, everyone **is using** the Internet.*
- are temporary.
***She's living** in London at the moment.*

We form the affirmative with **am, are** or **is** and the main verb with the **-ing** ending.

*read **reading***

When the main verb ends in **-e**, we take off the **-e** and add **-ing**.

*chase **chasing***

When the verb ends in vowel + consonant, we double the final consonant and add **-ing**.

*win **winning***

When the verb ends in **-ie**, we take off the **-ie** and add **-y** and **-ing**.

*lie **lying***

When the verb ends in **-l**, we double the **-l** and add **-ing**.

*travel **travelling***

Time expressions

We often use the following time expressions with the **present continuous**: **now, at the moment, these days, this year, today, tonight**, etc.

*I **am writing** a letter **at the moment**.*

*Monica **is working** a lot **these days**.*

*Simon **is staying** with his grandparents **tonight**.*

Affirmative

I'm falling (I am falling)
you're falling (you are falling)
he's falling (he is falling)
she's falling (she is falling)
it's falling (it is falling)
we're falling (we are falling)
you're falling (you are falling)
they're falling (they are falling)
