Romantic poets

Do you like poetry*? All these men were poets*. They lived at a time of change in history. For example, there were revolutions* in the United States, France and Ireland. The Romantics wanted to change poetry. They wanted more people to read and enjoy it. They tried to use language that everyone could understand.

Some of these poets were friends. Shelley and Byron travelled to Switzerland and Italy together. Keats lived in Rome for a time. Some of them were strange. Byron, for example, was described as 'mad, bad and dangerous to know!' All of them wrote great poetry.
