We use the infinitive of purpose to say why we do something.

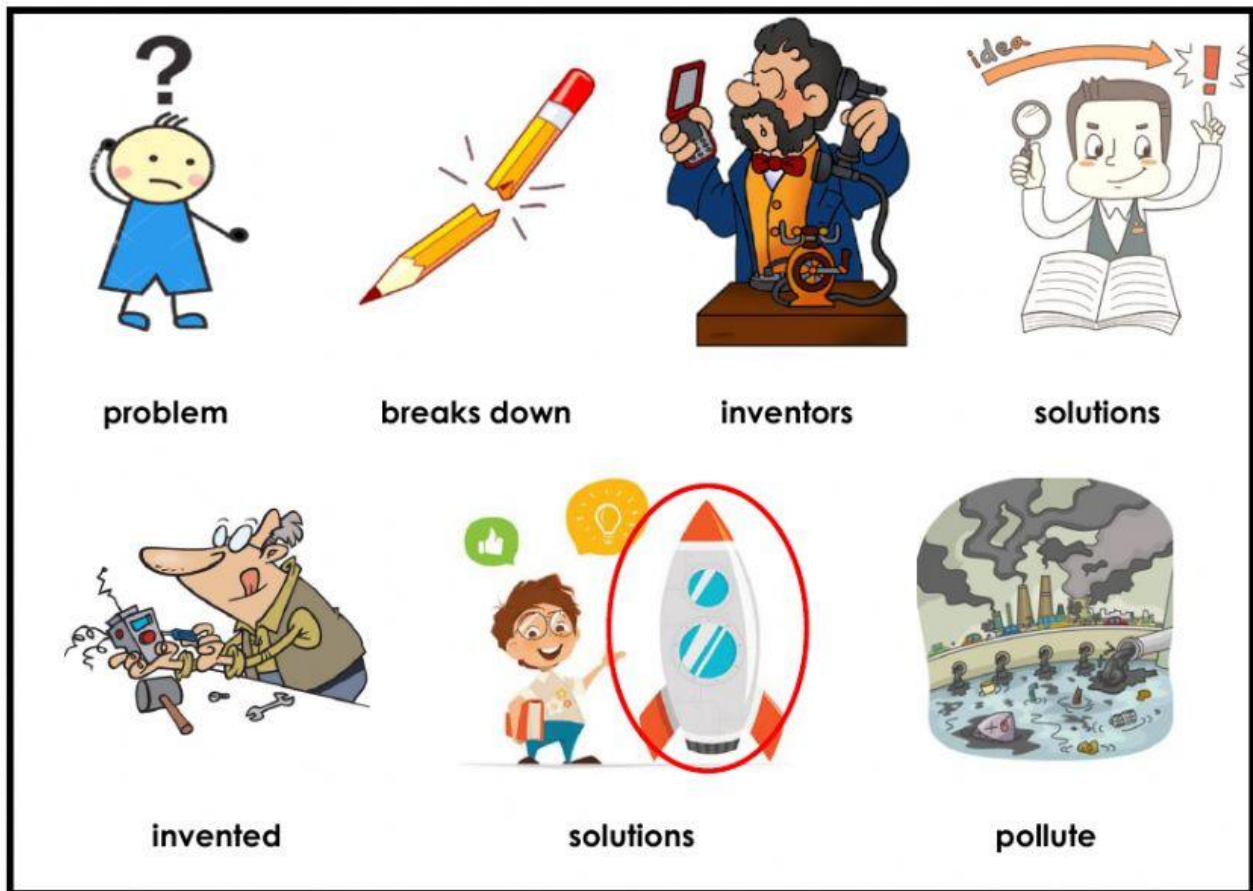
Daniel Burd did experiments **to discover** a way of breaking down plastic bags.

Why do you go to English classes? **To learn** to speak English.

Why do you brush your teeth? **To clean** them.
