Jack Jouett has often been called the "Paul Revere of the South." Though there are similarities between Jouett's and Revere's contributions to the American Revolution, many people only know about Paul Revere. That may be because Revere was made famous by American poet Henry Wadsworth Longfellow. In his narrative poem, "Paul Revere's Ride," Longfellow told the story of Revere's midnight ride to warn colonists that the British soldiers were coming (just before the battles of Lexington and Concord). However, some people believe that Jouett's actions are just as worthy of praise as Revere's.
