A part of a tree growing from the main trunk.		A round organ which contains a new plant shoot.
The sticky end of the female reproductive parts of the plant, where pollen from another plant is collected.		The male reproductive part of a plant, where pollen is created and then collected by insects and transported to another plant.
The part of a plant which attaches it to the ground, taking in water and nutrients and transporting them to the rest of the plant.		A part of a plant which is detached and is carried through a dispersal method to another location and turns into another plant.
The beginnings of a flower or leaf , where all the parts are compacted tightly together, ready to unfurl.		The part of a plant that bears seeds and makes reproduction possible; usually has colourful petals .
The main body of a plant which usually rises up above the ground.		The part of a stamen that contains pollen.
A young or new branch or stem .		A thin stalk inside a flower which supports the anther .
The part of a plant where photosynthesis takes place. Often flat and green, it is usually attached to the stem or via a stalk called a petiole.		A colourful segment of a flower , designed to protect the reproductive parts of the plant and to attract insects for pollination.
