Concept	Type of verb
An action verb that has a definite object that is being acted upon. <i>Un verbo de acción que tiene un objeto definido sobre el que se actúa.</i>	Action verbs
These verbs describes an actual action or process carried out by the subject, or a sensation that is felt by the subject. <i>Estos verbos describen una acción o un proceso real llevado a cabo por el sujeto, o una sensación que siente el sujeto.</i>	Stative verb
An verb that has no specific object that is being acted upon. <i>Un verbo que no tiene un objeto específico sobre el que se actúa.</i>	Intransitive verbs
Links the subject to a noun or adjective. This helps provide additional information about the subject. <i>Relaciona el sujeto con un sustantivo o adjetivo. Esto ayuda a proporcionar información adicional sobre el sujeto.</i>	Transitive verbs
These verbs tell us about the state of mind of the subject and the object. <i>Estos verbos nos hablan del estado de ánimo del sujeto y del objeto.</i>	Linking verbs
Describes the action the subject is going. <i>Describe la acción que realiza el sujeto.</i>	Dynamic verbs
