A superhero is a fictional character that can be found in books, films or comics. They often have superhuman powers and fight for good or to protect people. They usually have an interesting name and a special suit that might hide who they really are.

Who Was the First Superhero?

The first popular superhero was Superman. He was first shown in Action Comics in June 1938 but some fans think there are some even earlier characters.

Superman is also often called the Man of Steel because of his powers. Superman's alter ego is a man called Clark Kent, who works as a reporter for a newspaper called The Daily Planet.

When Did Superheroes Become Popular?

Superheroes first became popular in comics. As well as Superman, the characters Batman and Robin, Wonder Woman, Flash, Green Lantern and Plastic Man were all first seen in comics.

Plastic Man was created by a writer and artist called Jack Cole. He first appeared in Police Comics in 1941. He was able to stretch his body into all sorts of shapes, including a ball and a car. He later appeared in his own cartoon shown on TV from 1979 to 1981.
