

Rounding Fractions

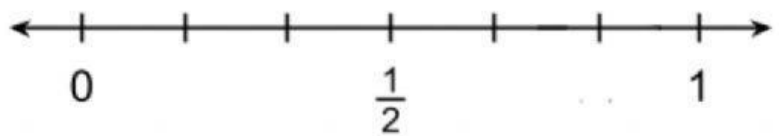
Use these rules to **round** Fractions

When the numerator is:	Round to:
much less than the denominator	0
about $\frac{1}{2}$ the denominator	$\frac{1}{2}$
about the same as the denominator	1

Use benchmark fractions such as 0, $\frac{1}{2}$, or 1 to round off the given fractions.

Select the correct bench mark fraction that each given fraction should round off to.

A Number line can make it easy to decide which benchmark fraction it is closet to



Round the fractions. Write about 0, about $\frac{1}{2}$, or about 1
