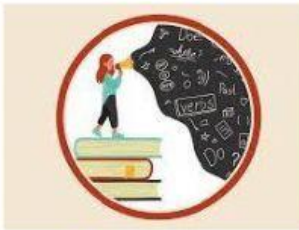


Literary Devices

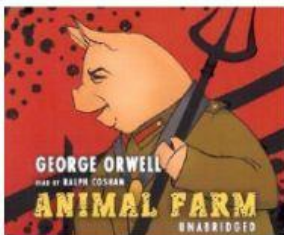

Diction

IS WHEN CHARACTERS ARE SPEAKING
DIRECTLY TO EVERYDAY PEOPLE, IT IS A
CONVERSATIONAL AND
NATURAL/RELAX WAY OF SPEAKING.



Allegory

IS BASICALLY THE USE OF SIMILAR
CONSONANTS RIGHT AFTER EACH
OTHER IN ORDER TO KIND OF MAKE
SOMETHING SOUND THE SAME.



Informal Diction

IT HAS TO DO WITH THE CHOICE OF
WORDS OR THE STYLE USED BY THE
AUTHOR TO CONVEY HIS MESSAGE



Alliteration

INSTEAD OF BEING LITERAL WITH AN
IDEA YOU USE CHARACTERS, EVENTS OR
OTHER ELEMENTS TO DESCRIBE THE
ABSTRACT IDEA IN A WAY THE READER
CAN BETTER UNDERSTAND IT



Hyperbole

IS A LITERARY DEVICE THAT
REFERENCES A PERSON, PLACE, THING
OR EVENT IN THE REAL WORLD



Allusion

ARE USED TO REPRESENT A CONCEPT
AND COMBINES A LOT OF IDEAS
PRESENTED IN METAPHOR



Symbolism

REFERS TO A KIND OF EXAGGERATED
DESCRIPTION OR STATEMENT.
