

PRESENT PERFECT



The form of the present perfect simple tense:

Subject + Have (in the simple present) + Verb (in the past participle form)

| Positive              | Negative                  | Question               |
|-----------------------|---------------------------|------------------------|
| I have worked there.  | I have not worked there.  | Have you worked there? |
| He has worked there.  | He has not worked there.  | Has he worked there?   |
| We have worked there. | We have not worked there. | Have we worked there?  |
