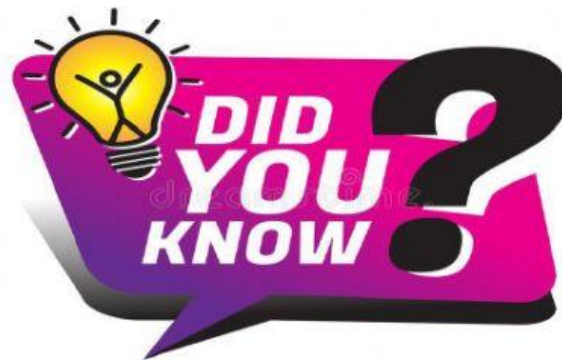

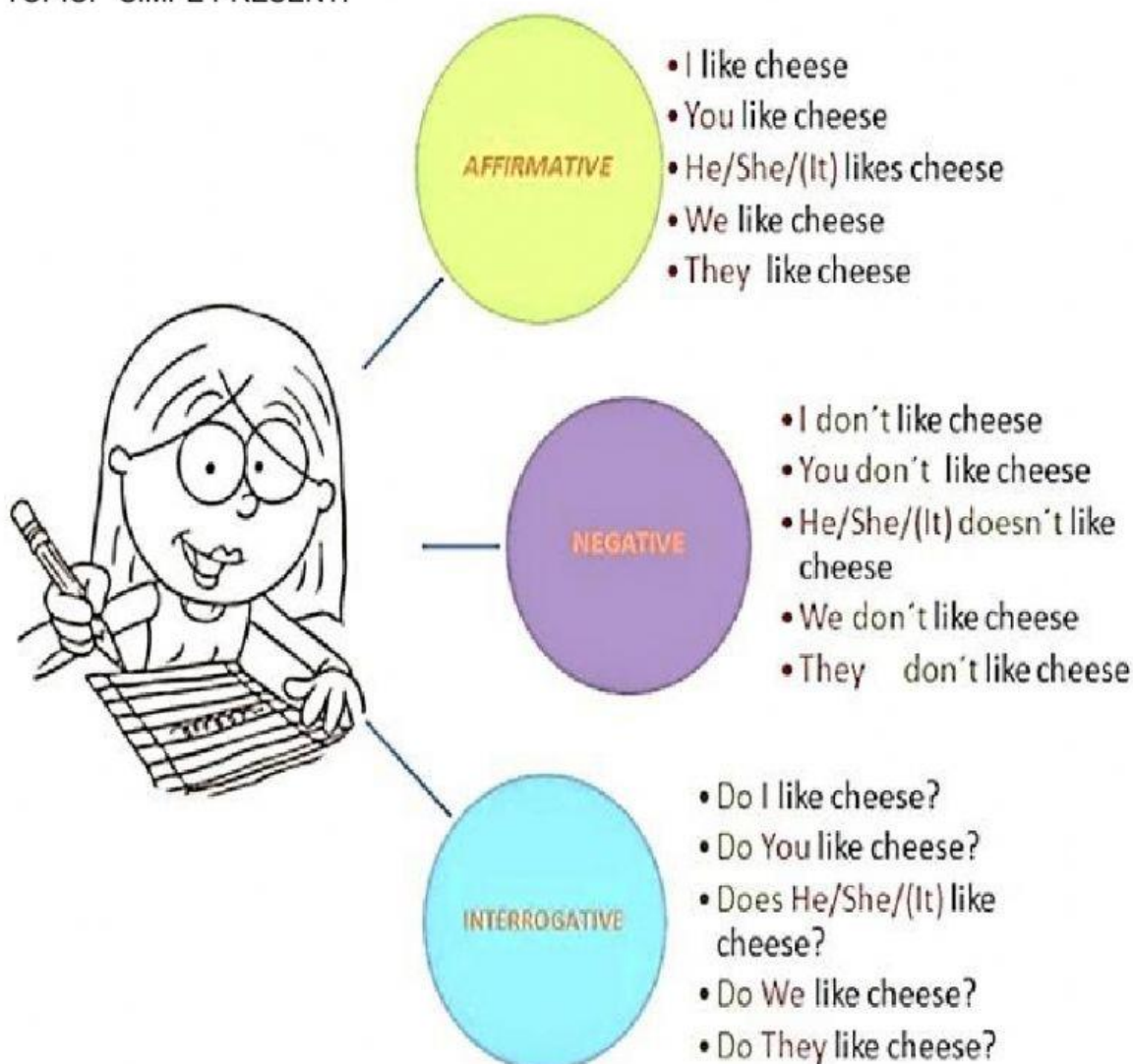

- a) **Add -s** for most verbs.

work - works, buy - buys, ride - rides, return - returns

- b) **Add -es** for words that end in – ch, – s, – sh, – x, o, or – z.

watch - watches, pass – passes, rush – rushes, relax – relaxes, buzz – buzzes.

- c) **Change the – y to –i/** and add – es when the base form ends in a consonant + y.

study – studies, hurry -hurries, dry – dries.

Do not change the -y when the base form ends in a vowel +y Add – s

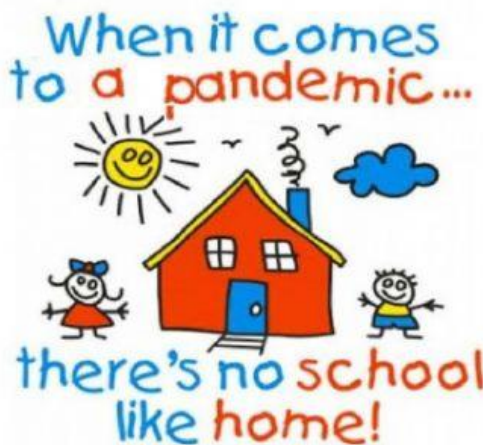
play – plays, enjoy – enjoys.

- d) A few verbs have **irregular – forms.**
