3. Chewing (present participle of 'to chew') -	not talking about or making obvious your abilities and achievements- humble, shy, not extreme
4. To give away -	used for emphasis, to indicate that something is the case to a fairly great extent
5. However -	to provide or donate something that you don't want or need
6. Concerned -	the activity of cutting and styling hair
7. Touring -	becoming successful or rich due to your own efforts
8. Hairdressing -	to be worried, preoccupied, anxious about something
9. Self-made -	to travel or explore an area
