

Read the text below and answer questions 1 to 8.

The Environment Society is organising a Cash for Trash Competition in conjunction with Earth Day. The aim of the competition is to encourage community members to collect as much recyclable materials in a month to raise funds for conservation purposes.

The competition runs for one month from July 1 to July 31. All recyclable materials can be dropped off at the Kinta Community Centre. Each team will be allocated a specific area to drop off their recyclables.

There are strict rules for the competition:

- ONLY recyclable materials are to be submitted, namely paper, plastic and aluminium cans
- All recyclable materials must be sorted
- The total number of members in each team must not exceed ten
- The team that collects the most recyclable materials in weight will win cash prizes
- Those interested can submit their application forms by 15 June. No late entries will be entertained.
