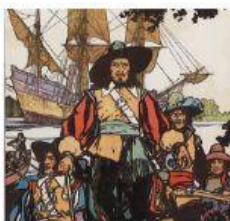

One of the most exciting nature spots you can see in North America is Niagara Falls. It is on the **border** of Canada & the U.S. It connects Lake Erie and Lake Ontario. It is made of 3 **waterfalls** called The Horseshoe Falls, The Bridal Falls, and Niagara Falls.

The falls were created about 10,000 years ago by melting glaciers. The first European to see them was the French **explorer**, Father Louis Hennepin, in December 1678. The drop is about 50 meters long. It is an important source of hydroelectric power.

Visitors to the Falls can do many things besides the **thrill** of standing and looking at them. You can take a boat ride near the falls and see the **rainbows** coming from the water. Don't forget to wear your **raincoat**! Near the falls you can find restaurants, amusement parks, museums, etc. So, if you like fun and nature, Niagara Falls is for you!
