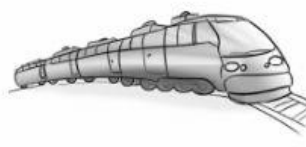

Twin boys, Romulus and Remus, were taken from their mother and left by the Tiber River to starve to death. A mother wolf found the babies and looked after them until they were old enough to take care of themselves. Years later, Mars (the Roman God of war) said to the boys: "Build a city where you were found." The two boys started building the city but ended up at war with each other. Romulus won the battle. He built the city and it became known as Rome. Today, historians and archeologists agree that people started living in Rome long before the time of Romulus and Remus, but many people still believe the legend.

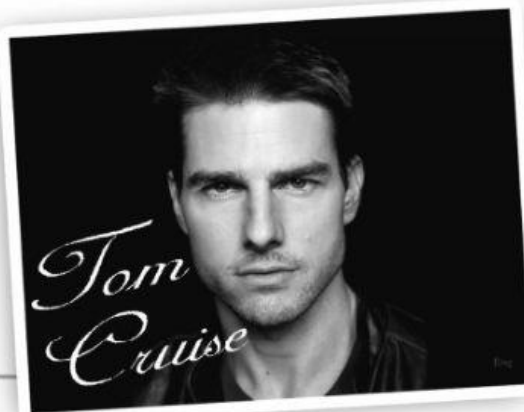
FUN FACT
