

'Used to'

B Form

► In the affirmative, we use the phrase **used to** followed by the infinitive of the verb. The phrase **used to** remains the same in all persons.
I used to like horror films when I was younger.

► The verb **use** in the phrase **used to** forms questions and negations like regular verbs. In questions and negations, no ending **-ed** is added to the verb.
Did you use to live in Paris? Did-you-used-to-live-in-Paris? X
I didn't use to like horror films. I-didn't-used-to-like-horror-films. X

Use

We use **used to** in order to describe habits or situations which existed in the past but not any longer.

We use **used to** if we want to stress the difference between what used to happen in then and what happens now.

She used to have cornflakes and milk for breakfast but now she just has a glass of orange juice.
