
Feeding relationships

Some animals like rabbits eat only plants (herbivores), and some like lions eat only meat (carnivores). Other animals like humans eat both plants and meat (omnivores). A food chain shows what an animal eats and what it is eaten by.



In this food chain, the **bird** is a **predator**, because it hunts other animals. The **caterpillar** is its **prey**, which means the animal which is hunted. The **leaf** is a **producer** because it makes its own food.

Endangered animals

Some species (types) of animals are very **common** – we see them often and there are lots of them. Other animals are **endangered**, which means the number of them is going down. This could be because their homes are destroyed or they get hunted. If we don't protect endangered species, they could become **extinct**, which means there will be none left.
