ZERO CONDITIONAL



FORM
If + present simple + present simple

USE
For facts that are generally true.

E.g. If I eat too much, I feel sick.

FIRST CONDITIONAL



FORM
If + present simple + will/ won't

USE
For things that may happen in the future.

E.g. If I don't hurry, I'll miss the van.

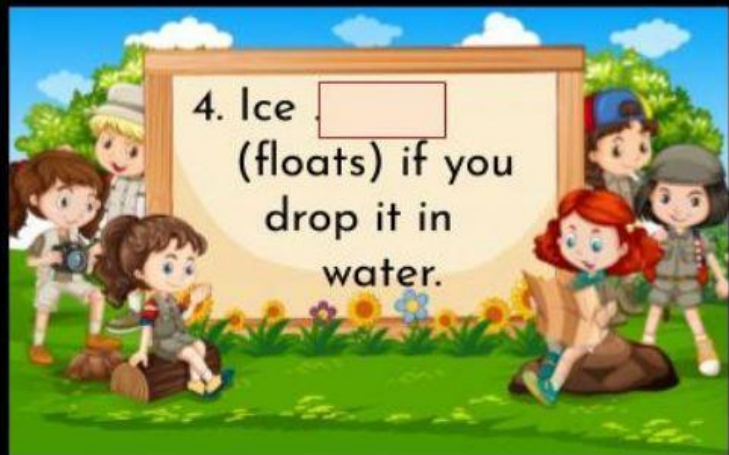

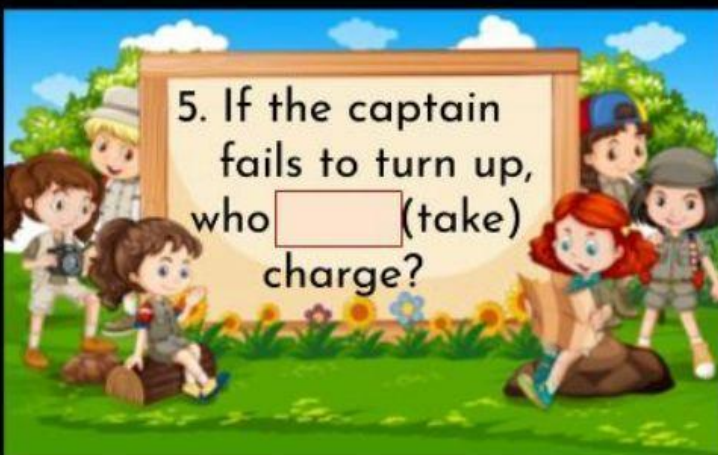
