

# COASTAL LANDSCAPE

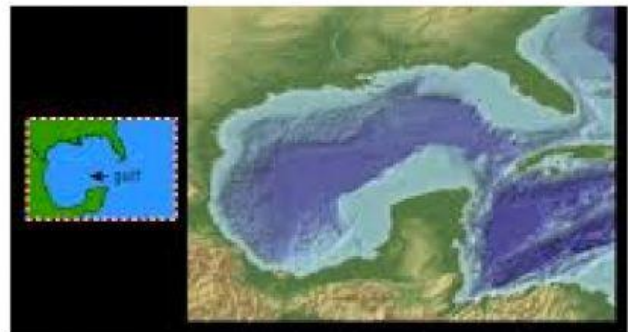
**BAY:** Where the coastline curves inwards and lets in the sea. Bays often have beaches.



**BEACH:** area of low, flat land next to the sea, made of sand or rocks.



A big bay is called **GULF.**



**HEADLANDS:** Narrow pieces of land that project from the coastline into the sea.



When the land rises abruptly from the sea and forms a wall of rock, we call it: **CLIFF**



**ISLAND:** an area of land completely surrounded by water.



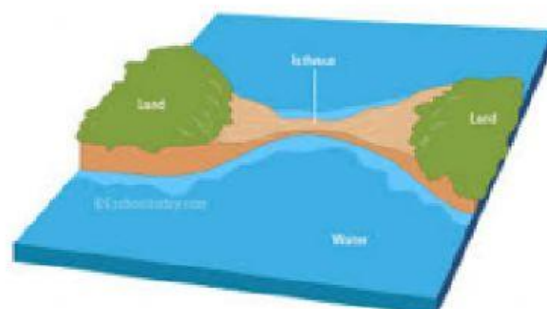
A group of islands is called an **ARCHIPELAGO**



**PENINSULA:** land surrounded by water on three sides.



The strip of land that connects a peninsula to the main land is called **ISTHMUS.**
