• Irregular verbs

В английском языке есть большая группа **неправильных глаголов**, которые образуют форму Past Simple не путем добавления **-ed** (см. список GR7): **go — went, see — saw, drink — drank**, etc. Их следует запомнить. Они образуют вопросы и отрицания также при помощи **did/did not (didn't)** и основной формы смыслового глагола.

He went out. — Did he go out? — He didn't go out.

Он вышел. — Вышел ли он? — Он не выходил.

УТВЕРДИТЕЛЬНАЯ ФОРМА

I/you/he/she/it/we/you/they **went**.

ОТРИЦАТЕЛЬНАЯ ФОРМА

I/you/he/she/it/we/you/they **didn't go**.

ВОПРОСИТЕЛЬНАЯ ФОРМА

Did I/you/he/she/it/we/you/they **go**?

КРАТКИЕ ОТВЕТЫ

Yes, I/you/he etc **did**. **No**, I/you/he etc **didn't**.
