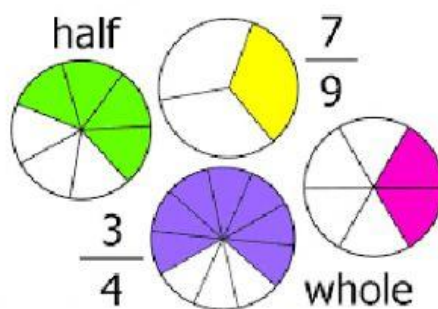


EQUIVALENT FRACTIONS
