

### 3- Climax



**C** – It is the stage in which the story begins to draw to a close. Events show the results of the important decision or action that happened at the climax.

**F** – It is the final outcome of the

**D** – It introduces or develops the conflict. Events occur that make the conflict get more complicated and build toward the climax.

**A** – It provides background information and introduces the setting, characters, and sometimes the conflict.

**B** – It is the point of greatest tension in the work. Here, the conflict is resolved, and the outcome becomes clear.
