### A. REMEMBER

Present perfect	Example
(+) S + have/has + <b>PII</b> (ed/ c3)	I have <b>done</b> all my homework.
(-) S + (have/ has) not + <b>PII</b> (ed/ c3)	We haven't <b>met</b> each other for a long time.
(?) Have/has + s + <b>PII</b> (ed/ c3) - Yes, S + have/ has. - No, S + haven't/ hasn't.	Have you ever <b>visited</b> that men? - Yes, I have. - No, I haven't.

#### Use:

- \* I, We, You ,They, N(s) – have
- \* He, She, It, N – has

#### Signal words:

- just, never, ever, recently, already, before.
- For + .....(for 10 years,...)
- Since + ..... (since 1998, since June,...)
- Yet (negative) I haven't eaten yet.
- So far = until now, up to now, up to the present.
